CANIFILE A DUE PROCESS COMPLAINT?

YES

You are a parent or public agency who believes there has been an IDEA violation.

and

The violation is regarding identification or evaluation of a student.

and/or

The violation is regarding the educational placement of a student with a disability.

and/or

The violation is regarding a provision of a free appropriate public education (FAPE) to a student with a disability.

and/or

You are appealing a district's Manifestation Determination Review (MDR) decision.

and

The violation in the complaint must have occurred not more than two years before the parent knew or should have known of the action.

NO

You have an issue with an individual staff member or school policy. The school or district should address this.

You believe there has been discrimination or a violation of a Section 504 Plan. The Office of Civil Rights addresses this. 504 plans fall under the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, not IDEA.

You believe there has been a violation of confidentiality or of student records. The US Dept. of Education- Student Privacy Office and FERPA should address this.

You believe that abuse or neglect has occurred.

Contact local law enforcement or Child Protective Services to address this.
